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
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
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Gospel of Thomas

Chapter 22: Jesus in the Secret Place

The disciples of Jesus wanted to know the place where he was coming from. "Show us the place where you are, since it is needful for us to seek it," they said to the Master.

Jesus replied, "Whoever has ears, let them hear. There is a divine light in the hearts and minds of the illuminated ones. It is a light that brings radiance to the entire world. If the light in that one burns out, then those around the other one also shall find themselves in darkness."

How can the light in THAT ONE ever be burnt out? This sounds so threatening or frightening.

Chapter 38: Identity of Jesus

Then his disciples inquired of him, "Who are you, that you should say these things to us?"

Jesus answered them, "You do not realize who I am from what I say to you; but you have become like most of the Jews; for these are the ones that either love the tree and hate its fruit, or love the fruit and hate the tree, not realizing that the tree and its fruit are inseparable.

"Whoever blasphemes against the Father will be forgiven; and whoever blasphemes against the Son will be forgiven; but whosoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven, either on Earth or in the heavenly realms."

Again it sounds so frightening. And who can not be forgiven? Isn't there forgiveness ALWAYS?

Chapter 43: "Solitary and Elect"

Jesus further enlightened his disciples, declaring that, "Blessed are the solitary and elect; for you will find the Kingdom. For you are from it; and to it you will return."

Jesus said, "If they ask you, 'Where do you come from?', reply thusly: 'We come from the Light, the place where the Light came into being on its own accord and established itself, becoming manifest through the image of the Elohim.'

"If they say to you, 'Is it you?', say "We are its children; and we are the elect of the Living Father.'



"And if they ask you, 'What is the sign of the Father in you?', say to them, "It is movement and ultimately resting in the assurance of having found my place in unification with God and his will."

Upon hearing these words, the disciples wanted to know when such a repose would come about, and when they should expect the end of the world. To this, the Master replied that, "What you look forward to has already come; but you do not recognize it."

Chapter 44: Words of the Prophets

Chapter 45: On Circumcision

Chapter 95: Fate of the Enlightened

Acts of Thomas

Chapter 2: Arrangements for the Journey
